The truth can be a frightening thing, particularly within the intellectual community. No-body wants to rock the boat, many have already been bought and paid for. To show any form of decent towards established fields could jeopardise existing careers etc.. I wrote a letter to the philosophy department at the Southern Cross University. No reply. With respect to Dr Kennedy, who may not have even received the letter, I would like to put ^{that letter} on this web site. Following that, some brief discourse that I have written. Once confirmation has been obtained through Justice Action I will wait. Wait for contact from people.

It is through those future E-mails and letters that I will continue to proceed. In putting this letter on my site, it is without malice towards Dr Kerruish or Southern Cross University. I respect her chosen field and do understand that a reply to me may compromise her in some way.
